



Restaurant Information:

Restaurants & other businesses walkable from the playing area:

Within the Hyatt:

- The **Olive Press**, an upscale restaurant, off the lobby. There is a lighter menu available also. The restaurant plans to have specials for the tournament. The restaurant has a bar which will remain open after the bridge game at night, if there is enough demand.
- There will be **cash sales** of sandwiches and snacks at lunchtime and during the session, if there is a demand. Coffee and soft drinks will be available for purchase during the sessions.

In the Airport:

There are two restaurants in the airport at the end of the walkway, accessible without going through security; these are a 5 minute walk from the playing area.

- Au Bon Pain serving bakery items, sandwiches, and soup; open 7 days a week from 5 AM until 10 PM
- City of Bridges Café, serving breakfast and lunch-type items, open 6 AM to 8:30 pm 6 days, and 6 AM to 6:30 PM on Saturdays

There are two other businesses in the airport, accessible without going through security: a convenience store, and a clothing/souvenir store.

Nearby Restaurants:

There are over 100 restaurants in the combined Robinson Towne Center/Pointe at North Fayette and University Boulevard areas. Each of these areas is approximately 10 minutes by car from the Hyatt. We are compiling a restaurant guide which will be available at the tournament, and it will also be posted on the website when it is complete.
