



Driving Directions:

From the Northwest: Take the PA Turnpike to Exit 10 (Toll 376); Take exit 6 (PA 576 E) toward the airport; follow signs to the Airport. See “In the Airport”, below.

From the North: Take I-79 exit 22A. Merge onto PA 60-N toward the Airport. Follow the signs to the Airport. See “In the Airport”, below.

From the East: Take the PA Turnpike to exit 57 (Monroeville). Follow 376 (US22) West. Continue to follow the signs to the Airport, which will take you past downtown and 376 becomes I 279 (still US 22 west). Take PA 60, then PA 576 East, entering Airport property. See “In the Airport”, below.

From the West: Take US 30 to 576, following signs to the Airport. See “In the Airport”, below.

From the South: Take I-79 to US 22/30 W toward Airport. Merge onto 60N toward Airport. Follow signs to the Airport. See “In the Airport”, below.

Once in the Airport :

Once on airport property, follow the signs to the Hyatt. You will see the Hyatt on your left. See parking below.

Parking:

If you are checking in to the Hyatt, pull into the small lot in front of the Hyatt. You will move your car after you have checked in. Otherwise follow directions below: Pass the Hyatt on your left and follow the road around to the left, following the signs to “Hyatt Parking”. Hyatt Parking is an area within Airport Long Term Parking. Take a ticket upon entering the lot and proceed to a spot in or near the area called “Hyatt Parking”. You may also park in any space in the Long Term or Extended lots.

Do not park in short term parking. Your parking pass will not work in short term parking.

There is Handicapped parking immediately outside the meeting area. There are entrances to the meeting area directly from Hyatt parking. You do not need to go through the main part of the hotel. At Tournament Registration, request a parking pass. Submit the pass at the toll booth when you are leaving. Get a new parking pass each time you park.
